Former F1 Chief Doctor, Gary Hartstein, has warned that fans must prepare themselves "for the worst" as attempts to awaken Michael Schumacher are failing following his horrific ski accident in France.

Schumacher suffered severe brain injuries after hitting his head oN a rock whilst skiing in December.

His manager, Sabine Kehm, has said that awakening the seven-time world champion is turning out to be a long and drawn out process and that he and the family will wait for "as long as it takes".

Dr. Hartstein has also said that "the longer it takes - the less likely it is that Schumacher will ever recover.

After speaking to three people about Michael Schumacher's condition, they all said they are very "devastated", "upset" and that they "felt sorry for the family".
