Term 1 & 2	All About Me: Basic Reading & Writing Skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Write the letters of the alphabet in sequence and in both upper and lower case - Use the first and second letters to sequence words in alphabetical order - Use the first, second and third place letters to sequence
		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Punctuate simple sentences with a capital letter and full stop - Use basic punctuation correctly (e.g. full stops, capital letters, question marks) - Use a range of punctuation correctly (e.g. full stops, question marks, exclamation marks, commas)
Term 3	Adventure – Non fiction texts.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand simple text on a simple subject - Understand organisational markers in a text - Use illustrations, images and captions to locate information - Understand organisational features and use them to locate relevant information (e.g. contents, index, menus, tabs & links) - Identify, understand and extract the main points and ideas from a text
Term 4	News & Media: Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Communicate information in words, phrases and simple sentences - Write in compound sentences using common conjunctions - Use adjectives and simple linking words in an appropriate way - Write in compound sentences and paragraphs where appropriate - Use language appropriate for purpose and audience - Communicate information, ideas and opinions clearly and in a logical way
Term 5	Careers: Writing & Speaking & Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Communicate information in words, phrases and simple sentences - Complete a form asking for personal information (e.g. first name, surname, address, postcode, age, date of birth) - Use appropriate format and structure when writing straightforward texts, including the appropriate use of headings and bullet points
