Dear Parents and Carers,

This afternoon we have received information from the Local Authority regarding their current provision of 'home to school' transport at Corby Business Academy. They have requested that we pass this information to you.

Unfortunately, the Local Authority have informed us they have been unable to secure sufficient vehicles to allow for the planned social distancing on all of the school transport routes. However, they have stated that there is sufficient capacity for all students to be transported to the Academy; but some routes will not include the level of social distancing that had been originally planned for.

What this means is that on some routes there will not be a one metre distance between year group pods on the bus.

Following this announcement, should you wish to transport your children into the Academy there is a mileage allowance available to families at the standard HMRC rate of 45 pence per mile for the first 10,000 miles. If you would like to contact the Local Authority to discuss this matter further, again, please liaise with them directly.

Please rest assured we will continue our correspondence with Local Authority over the coming days with the intention of informing you of any changes.

As a final reminder, all students are expected to wear a face covering whilst using bus transport and until they arrive inside their faculties each morning. At the end of school, face coverings should be worn when exiting their faculties and worn on bus transport.
