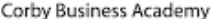

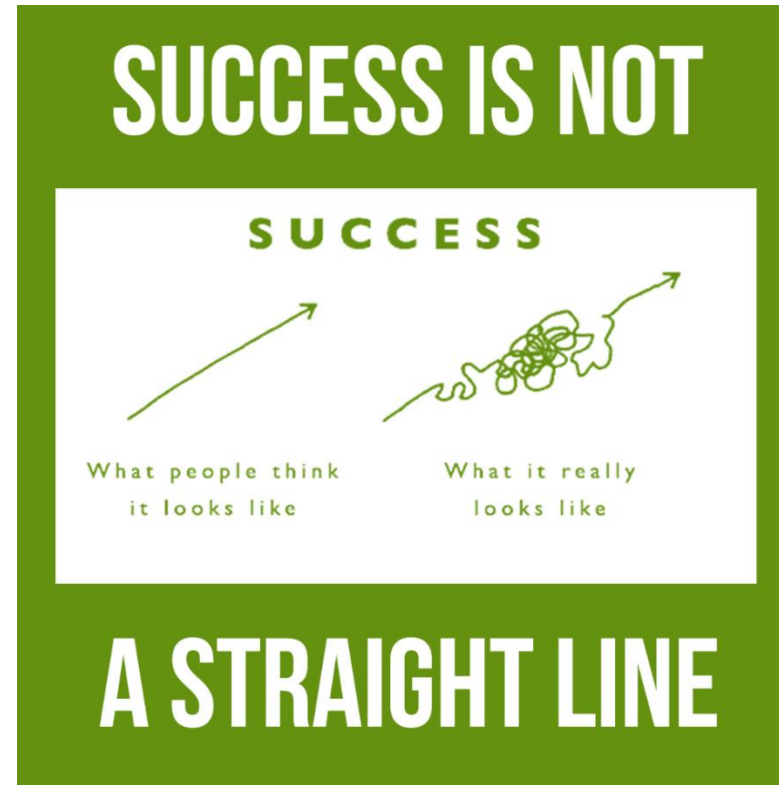

Application for a school place in Year 7 in September 2024

- ▶ All applications for a place at the Academy must be made through the Local Authority using the Common Preference Form. Applications can be made online.
- ▶ The opening date for applications is 8 September 2023 and the closing date is 31 October 2023. After this deadline you will need to make a late application.
- ▶ Please note that you will be required to submit three preferences. Applicants cannot be guaranteed that they will be offered one of their preferences.
- ▶ Please contact us, or the Local Authority, if you need help to complete your application and we will support you.

School admissions arrangements for children with SEND - North Northamptonshire

If your child has an education, health and care (EHC) plan there is a separate process for your child's school admission:

1. Our Education, Health and Care Team will send you a letter seeking details of your school preference.
2. You will be asked to return your preference within 15 days.
3. You will be informed of the outcome of this consultation by 15 February of the year in which you're applying.

If you disagree with this decision, you can then appeal to the Special Educational Needs and Disability Tribunal (SEND) by visiting our [Mediation and disagreement resolution page](#).

What if an education, health and care statutory needs assessment is in progress?

Primary school applications

- If your child has an education, health and care statutory needs assessment in progress you will need to complete a preference form and [apply for a primary school place in the usual way](#).
