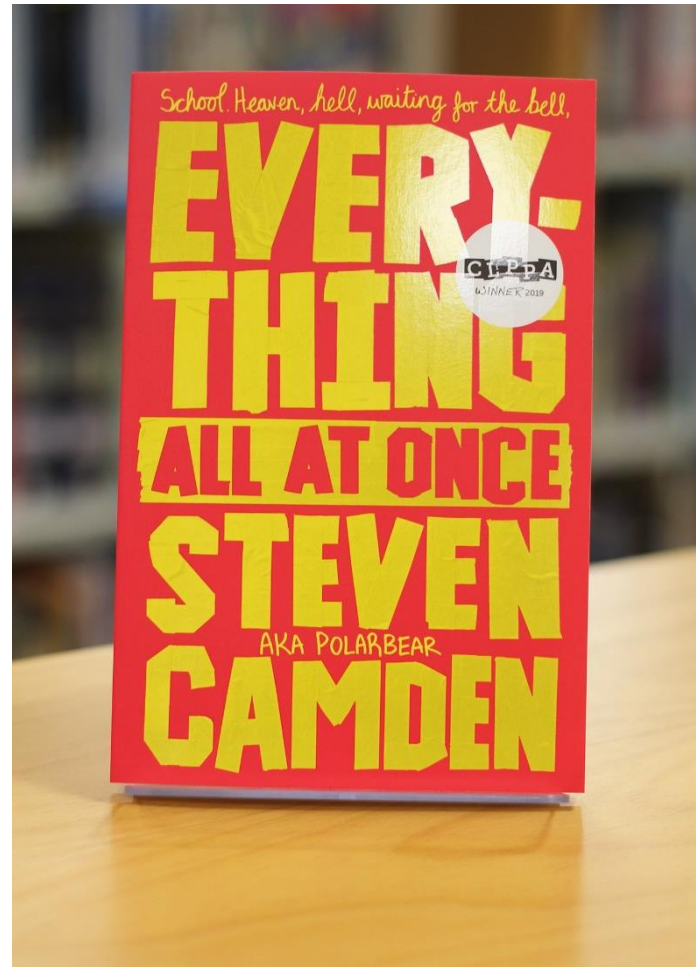
Parent Payment System WisePay
