Week 2 beginning 8 th June	Sculpture: Paper Manipulation In this lesson we will be creating sculpture by manipulating paper. We will use basic materials to construct an abstract piece. We will then explore this object using light and photography. Link to Video	 Your outcome will be a paper sculpture which you will photograph and submit to your teacher via Microsoft Teams. You should include a self-assessment with a 'WWW and EBI' via word or handwritten on paper and photographed. ✓ Task 1- Photograph of paper sculpture and self-assessment (WWW and EBI) ✓ Extension- Choose one of the paper sculptures by Pablo Picasso and write a review on it for a local magazine.
