Week 2 beginning 8 th June	<p><u>Sculpture: Paper Manipulation</u></p> <p>In this lesson we will be creating sculpture by manipulating paper. We will use basic materials to construct an abstract piece. We will then explore this object using light and photography.</p> <p>Link to Video</p>	<p>Your outcome will be a paper sculpture which you will photograph and submit to your teacher via Microsoft Teams. Week 3 beginning 15 th June	<p><u>Sculpture: Creating a sculpture inspired by natural forms</u></p> <p>In this lesson we are going to continue our exploration into paper manipulation by creating a sculpture inspired by natural forms.</p> <p>Link to Video</p>	<p>Your outcome will be a paper sculpture which you will photograph and submit to your teacher via Microsoft Teams.
