Term 1	Self-help / social skills and independence (independence)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Turning taking games with peers - Listening Skills – a range of tasks to encourage development of listening skills - Fine motor skills – using a variety of different tasks to encourage development of fine motor skills - Circle time – using a variety of games to interact and listen to peers. - Lego challenges – a range of challenges to see if instructions can be followed
Term 2	Commando / Nature studies (Communication, teamwork and problem solving)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exploring nature
Term 3	Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Effectively communicating with peers - Games / role play
Term 4	Community (Life and social skills)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Accessing the local community - Road Safety - Safety - Listening - Accessing local shops/parks
Term 5	Swimming (Gross Motor Skills)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Independently get dressed and undressed for swimming. - Ensuring student has all their belongings before and after lesson - Swimming / water time
Term 6	Bespoke	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Gross motor skills - Tying Laces - Tying a tie - Zips - Garden time
