Term 1	Using Recycled Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify different types of recyclable materials - Explores the use of different recyclable materials to create art - Safe use of tools and equipment to make art
Term 2	Introduction to French	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Introduction to French culture - Introduction to French language - Develop understanding of France through practical learning and play
Term 3	Using Bread	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ‘The Great Bread Bake Off’ – The History Behind Warburtons - Practice skills to follow instructions to make a sandwich - Follow different recipes using bread e.g. jam on toast, beans on toast, toasted sandwiches, sandwiches - Establish and follow health and safety routines
Term 4	Weaving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discuss and explains design ideas - Select and use different materials which are appropriate for the task - Identify simple processes needed to develop a product
Term 5	Clay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Build models with clay or pliable materials using a variety of techniques - Describe the purpose of their product, including what or who their product is for - Compare their completed work simply against their original design criteria - Sculpture artist
Term 6	Healthy Eating and Snacks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Identify which foods are healthy and unhealthy - Express opinion with appropriate language - Identify some healthy elements of their packed lunch, school dinner or other meals - Make different healthy snacks - Healthy snack tasting and review
