Important

- Once the 400-person limit has been reached for each session, no further bookings will be accessible for that session.
- Visitors will not be allowed to participate or enter the Academy upon arrival without:
 - ✓ Successfully registering online for the designated session
 - ✓ Print out or mobile device evidence of booking confirmation email

2021 Open Event organisation and rationale

- We have arranged three shorter one-hour sessions this year to sustain our commitment towards Covid control measures in the community, as well as ensure we still cater for the large volumes of visitors we receive during these events.
- To support as many students as possible with a visit to the Academy, we will be asking that just the Year 6 student and one parent or carer attends the evening. If you are the parent or carer of multiple siblings currently in Year 6, please contact Reception on 01536 303120 to organise your place.
- A maximum of 400 people will be admitted during each individual session, with 30-minute intervals to support academy staff with infection control / cleaning measures. This also allows visitors to exit the building and academy site without cross-over.
- Covid control measures and organisation information are in place to support the current climate and enable us to host a public gathering. Please see the following page for the guidelines and work with us to keep our community safe.

Event information and Covid infection control

Arrival on site

- Please do not enter the Academy site more than 10 minutes before your scheduled session
- If arriving by car, please use the top / visitors' carpark situated on your left when you arrive through the Academy gates. If this carpark becomes full, please follow instructions from our site team for alternative parking arrangements
- Disabled / accessible carparking is available in the lower carpark. This will need to registered as part of your session booking form
- If arriving by taxi, you can be dropped off at the Academy entrance. Please can we ask for a prompt pick up at the end of your allocated session
- If travelling by bus, there is a bus stop located just outside the Academy gates. Please see a link to appropriate bus route timetable: 2A Corby CBA Stagecoach Midlands bustimes.org

Arrival at reception doors

- When walking from the Academy gates or visitors' carpark, please use the pedestrian pathway that is located on the right and nearest to our AstroTurf facility
- Upon arrival to the Academy building there will be numerous sign-in desks. Please approach any of these desks, all personnel will have the session's registered names and can sign you in with your booking receipt
- You will then be directed through to the main academy building, where you can begin your Open Event experience

Visiting Faculties, viewing activities and speaking to staff

- The bottom floor of Faculties will be open for visitors to observe the building layout, view live learning activities and speak to specialist teachers
- In the Academy's UNIT provision, visitors will be able to visit both the lower and upper area of the Faculty
- Activities will be in classrooms, with the classroom door open. Visitors can listen and observe through the large glass partitions which each classroom is designed with
- Subject Teachers and Leaders will be also be situated at tables throughout each faculty for any questions you may have

Main Theatre Presentation

- To support the shorter session times this year, the presentation will be condensed to 15 minutes. However, further detailed presentations will be available as part of our virtual open event resources
- Prompt start times are as follows:

- Please can we ask that visitors take their seats from the far right when entering, to support the flow of movement and prevent interaction that is avoidable

Exiting the building and site at the end of each session

- Visitors will exit the Academy through the Fire Exit Doors in the Main Theatre, not through the entrance doors at the front of the building
- Visitors can then exit by the side of the Academy building towards the lower carpark
- Once through the side gate of the Academy, access to the top carpark and main gates will be done via the pedestrian on the right nearest to the access road

Covid infection control measures

Face Coverings

- We require all adult visitors to wear face coverings whilst inside the Academy for the hour session
- Those who are medically exempt, please can you wear an appropriate lanyard or medical evidence card to signify this
- We understand that children under the age of 11 have not been directed to wear masks in public settings, therefore this is a personal choice for parent / carers and their child to make together. Whilst we will not be insisting on this, we would appreciate your support in this matter if possible

Main Mall One Way system

- To support the flow of movement through the Academy, when accessing faculties and the Main Theatre, the Main Mall has a one-way system. Please follow the signage and markings when moving through the building

Hand Sanitisation

- Please frequently use the hand sanitisation stations throughout the Academy, especially if touching door handles or surface areas

Covid Symptoms and Testing

- Whilst we will not be requesting proof of a negative test upon arrival, we do ask that visitors are conscientious and work within the current Government Guidelines
- Please do not attend the Open Event if:
 - you have Covid symptoms
 - you have not been conducting twice weekly LFD testing
 - if you have tested positive from a LFD or PCR test
 - ✗ if you are awaiting the results of a PCR test
 - if you have not completed your isolation period after a positive test
