The DfE have again asked secondary schools to perform Lateral Flow Tests on students when they return for a new term, in this case - after Christmas holidays. To support this process, and enable adequate staffing levels, we will be operating a staggered return for students.

Registering LFD tests at home

To reduce the disruption to teaching and learning in the Academy we will not be asking students to register their LFD tests on site. This allows us to test more students in a day and ensure we get everyone into normal lessons as quickly as possible. All test results will be recorded using the NHS Track and Trace portal. If a student tests positive on site we will ensure that their test is registered before we send them home and that parents are informed immediately. Negative tests can be registered at home using the link below, using the barcode on the student test card and the Test Site ID CBAC.
