



Remote Learning and Registering Covid Tests

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, term starts tomorrow for all of students. Whilst Year 11 and 6th form will be joining us in the building tomorrow, our teachers have provided remote learning for all students until their return date. This staggered start allows us to provide the DfE recommended on-site Covid testing for all students, reduce transmission and to keep our community as safe as possible. Your child will only be tested on site if you have given consent using the link shared during the final weeks of Term 2.

Accessing Remote Learning

Registering LFD tests at home

To reduce the disruption to teaching and learning in the Academy we will not be asking students to register their LFD tests on site. This allows us to test more students in a day and ensure we get everyone into normal lessons as quickly as possible. All test results will be recorded using the NHS Track and Trace portal. If a student tests positive on site we will ensure that their test is registered before we send them home and that parents are informed immediately. Negative tests can be registered at home using the link below, using the barcode on the student test card and the Test Site ID CBAC.
