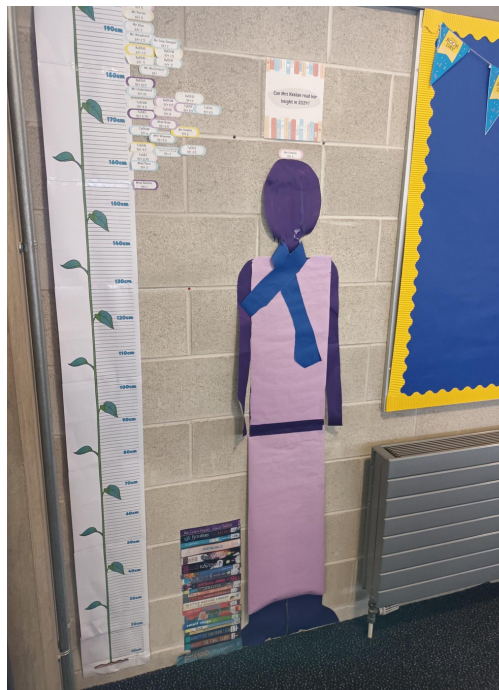

in 2024?**

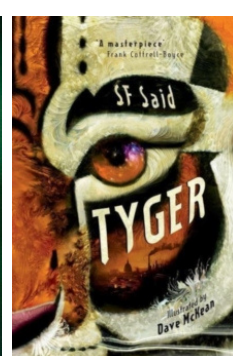
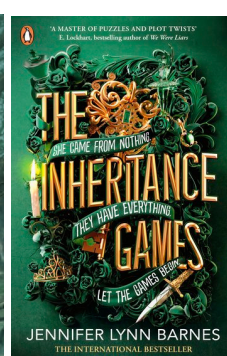
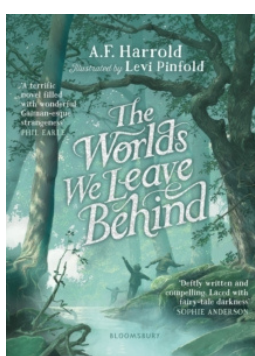
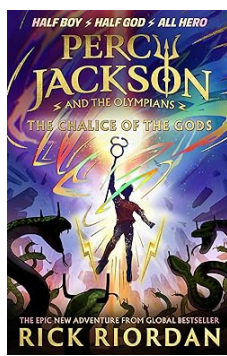
Key Stage 3 had a lot of fun during
