Please note that we will be standing for the entire production in the Immersive Area. At no point will we be allowed to sit down in the production which lasts for approximately three hours. Please bear that in mind when booking onto this trip! This is a relatively new concept for musical theatre and it means at times we will be part of the action!

If you would like your child to be considered for the trip, please make the deposit payment of £22.00 via WisePay by Friday 17th May 2024. The final balance of £20.00 is due by Friday 21st June 2024. All payments must be made through WisePay by accessing the Trips module and selecting 'Guys and Dolls'. All monies are non-refundable should students no longer wish to attend unless we are able to fill the space from our waiting list.

Students will be supervised at all times. Please note students do not need to come to school on the morning of the trip. The meet and collection point will be at Corby Railway Station. There will be an opportunity to go for a short
